AGM and HISTORIC STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS

Prior to the AGM it is proposed that we will have a discussion and vote on whether or not our club should promote a State Championship in 2016.

As many of you are aware, the last time we ran a State Championship was in 2012. We did not run a State Championship in 2013 because we promoted the Australian National Championships.

In 2014 we discovered that MWA had implemented a \$100 fee for every State Championship trophy awarded. As an example, if we ran a State championship and we had seven classes with enough entrants to constitute a State Championship class, and first, second and third were awarded, we would have to pay MWA \$2100. This fee is on top of the cost of running the event. The fee goes towards funding MWA's annual dinner and awards presentation night.

Recently MWA offered to waive the transponder hire fee if our club were to run a State Championship. Riders would still have to pay the transponder hire fee however the club would not have to pass the hire fee on to MWA. We would have to use the money to pay some of the State Championship Trophy fee. Initial estimates suggest the saving from the transponder hire fee would cover about half of the State Championship Trophy fee.

For many club members this issue is not so much about the money, it's more about MWA deciding that they will award the State Championship trophies at a dinner that very few of our members attend and our club, or more to the point our riders, will have to pay for the privilege.

So please come to the AGM and vote for our 2016 club executive and have your say regarding the running of a State Championship event in 2016.
